Tournament Rules

- Players will start with 25,000 in tournament chips.
- Registration until the end of level 9 of this event.
- Tournament tickets are non-refundable \& non-transferable for this event.
- $\$ 1,000$ will go into the prize pool. $\$ 25$ will go towards the staff; $\$ 75$ is the registration fee.
- This is scheduled as a 2 day tournament with one day 1 start time.
- In the event play on day two is not complete at 3:00 AM play will cease and begin back at 2:00 PM the following day. Players will have the option, if one table remains at 3:00 AM to play the tournament out until there is a winner if all players agree.
- Levels will be 40 minutes in duration.
- Break every two hours. One hour dinner break after level 8
