Tournament Rules

- Players will start with 25,000 in tournament chips.
- Registration until the end of level 9 of this event.
- Tournament tickets are non-refundable & non-transferable for this event.
- \$1,000 will go into the prize pool. \$25 will go towards the staff; \$75 is the registration fee.
- This is scheduled as a 2 day tournament with one day 1 start time.
- In the event play on day two is not complete at 3:00 AM play will cease and begin back at 2:00 PM the following day. Players will have the option, if one table remains at 3:00 AM to play the tournament out until there is a winner if all players agree.
- Levels will be 40 minutes in duration.
- Break every two hours. One hour dinner break after level 8
- Day one play will conclude at the end of level 14 or at 12% of the field, whichever comes first
- Any unauthorized chips introduced into tournament play will be immediately removed upon detection without substitution. Any parties determined to be responsible for the introduction of said chips will be disqualified without refund. It's every player's responsibility to bring to management's attention unusual chips, circumstances or irregularities.
- Residents of foreign countries without U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding
