- Day 1 will end at the conclusion of level 18 (Tournament Director's discretion may be used). Day 2 will resume at 3PM the following day and play until completion.
- Registration will remain open until the beginning of level 13.
- $\frac{1}{2}$ hour dinner break at the completion of level 8.
- Any unauthorized chips introduced into tournament play will be immediately removed upon detection without substitution. Any parties determined
 to be responsible for the introduction of said chips will be disqualified without refund. It's every player's responsibility to bring to management's
 attention unusual chips, circumstances, or irregularities.
