## ID REQUIREMENTS

---

We are required to gather identification from patrons whenever a jackpot or other winnings reach the tax reportable threshold. When we issue a form W2G or .1099 we are required to obtain 2 forms of identification.

Below is a matrix which shows the types of acceptable primary ID needed to be obtained along with acceptable types of second ID.
