- Players will start with 3,000 in tournament chips.
- All “ring” events qualify to earn points for the 2018 WSOP Global Casino Championship. Must be 21 years old to be eligible for Global Casino Championship or points.
- \$100 rebuys anytime you are at or below 3K in chips for six levels. Optional \$100 add-on for 3K in chips or \$200 add-on for 6K in chips available at the conclusion of level six and prior to the start of level seven.
- Day 1 will end at the conclusion of level 18 (Tournament Director’s discretion may be used). Day 2 will resume at 3PM the following day and play until completion.
- Registration will remain open until the beginning of level 7.
- ½ hour dinner break at the completion of level 8.
- Any unauthorized chips introduced into tournament play will be immediately removed upon detection without substitution. Any parties determined to be responsible for the introduction of said chips will be disqualified without refund. It’s every player’s responsibility to bring to management’s attention unusual chips, circumstances, or irregularities.
